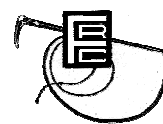

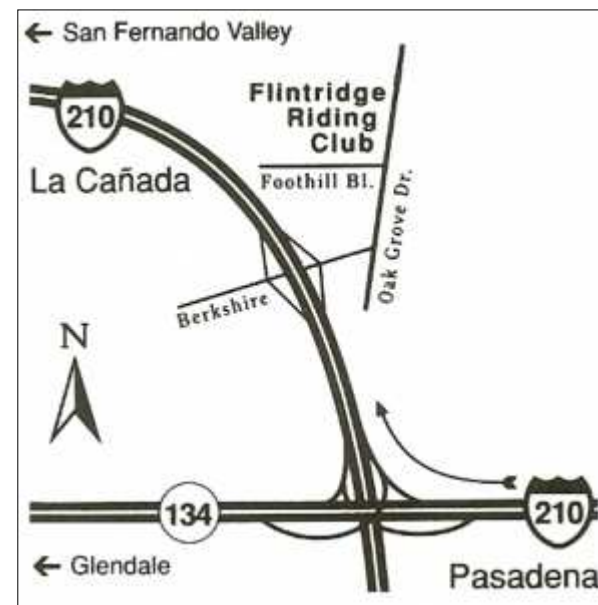

FRC/SFHJA Rules and Definitions

- Classes with less than three entries will be combined or cancelled.
- This show will follow the rules of the USEF except where in conflict with the SFHJA, in which SFHJA will prevail.
- Minor Exhibitors: Parents or guardians of minor exhibitors shall hold FRC/SFHJA harmless from injury to such minor. No child's entry shall be accepted without the signature of a parent or guardian. The signature of instructors, agents, or other unrelated persons are not acceptable.
- FRC reserves the right to make all management decisions regarding the operation of the horse show and conditions of competition allowed under the sanctioning organizations.
- The current USEF helmet rules in effect will be strictly enforced.
- Rules for Medal Classes: Medal classes are open to junior and adult amateur members who are in good standing with SFHJA per medal class respectively. Trainers to be competitors in the SFHJA medals must also be members of the SFHJA in good standing. All Medal specifications for the SFHJA Medal classes will be found at the horse show office.
- RESTRICTED CHILD/ADULT DIVISION: See specifications in SFHJA rule book. Fences to be set at 2'6".
- SHORT, LONG, & RUSTY STIRRUP DIVISION: Riders may not compete in classes where fences are set higher than 2'6". Fences 2'3".
- CROSS RAIL DIVISION: Riders may not compete in any classes where fences may be set at 2'3" or higher at any show. Cross Rail classes count for SFHJA year end points in shows rated SFHJA "B".
- CHILDREN'S HUNTERS: Open to horses and ponies ridden by a Junior Exhibitor. Horses and riders may not cross enter into any classes at the same show with fences 3'6" or higher. Horses and ponies will NOT be jogged.
- ADULT AMATEUR HUNTERS: Open to horses ridden by Amateurs who are no longer eligible to compete as Juniors. Adult Amateur horses and riders may not cross enter into any Amateur Owner Hunter class at this show. In addition, Adult Amateur riders may not cross enter into any class at this show with fences 3'6" or higher that offers prize money (except Adult Amateur Jumpers.) Horses will not be jogged.
- Ponies must present measurement cards.

FRC Rules and Definitions

1. All Classes to be conducted using USEF rules or SFHJA Rules where applicable.
 2. All riders or parents of minors or minors with guardians must sign the FRC release before riding anywhere on the property.
 3. USEF Helmet rule is applicable at all times.
 4. Stabling reservations must be made in advance. Please call (818) 952-1289 - Joaquin Gomez – Stable Manager.
 5. Lead Line open to Riders 6 years of age and younger who have never shown at a higher level.
 6. FRC Medal 2'9" to count for year end points to qualify for Final at FRC Autumn Classic September 28-30, 2012. Full FRC Medal specs available at the Horse Show Office.
 7. Trail Class open to all riders. Each obstacle has a 60-second time allotment. Class to be scheduled at 12:00 High Noon.
 8. Western Pleasure to be shown at walk, trot and favorite gate.
 9. Field Classes are open to all riders.
 - a. Riders will be permitted to hack (no jumping) around the hunt field prior to the start of classes.
 - b. Classes are open to all ages of competitors.
 - c. Classes are open to horses and ponies. Distances will not be adjusted for ponies.
 - d. Competitors will be judged on performance, hunter pace, jumping style, quality, pace and handiness.
 - e. Obstacles will simulate those of the hunt field and will offer a variety of classic jumps with different appearances. Banks, ditches and option fences may be offered.
- Please direct any questions regarding these classes to our show manager. We welcome comments and look forward to seeing you "out in the field"!*
10. Riders not showing in SFHJA classes do not have to join SFHJA. Except for Lead Line, Trails, and Western Class. \$5.00 is charged per horse by SFHJA.
 11. Riders pay only for classes and warm-ups completed. Pre-entries who do not show will receive a refund.
 12. Riders are encouraged to pre-enter to take advantage of pre-entry discount. Pre-entries must be received by the show secretary by 5pm Feb 9, 2012.
 13. All Horses registered in the show are subject to the CA Drug Fee charge.
 14. Riders will be charged for classes entered only. Adds and scratches will be tallied at the end of the day or upon check-out.
 15. Containers are available and all sharps must be placed in proper receptacles.
 16. Schooling is permitted in show rings when show in not in progress. Specified arenas will be open for schooling before the competition.
 17. Ticketed Warm-ups will be held from 7am-8am on Saturday. Show will accommodate "all day" warm-ups. It is the rider's responsibility to clarify a warm-up round with the starter at the back-gate BEFORE entering the arena. If not clarified, the round will be considered a "judged" round.
 18. Classes may be moved to adjacent ring at management discretion.
 19. No schooling while rings are being set or during water and drag sessions.
 20. Veterinarian and farrier on-call.
 21. All FRC Classes are non-rated.
 22. Dogs must be kept on leash and under control at all times.
 23. Food is available in the Clubhouse from 7am through the end of the show.
 24. No RVs or hookups.
 25. No Golf Carts please.
 26. Decisions reached by the show management are final.
